The first phase will see each team playing the others once, thus thirteen games in phase 1. At the conclusion of the first phase, the Division will split into two groups of seven teams according to final position. Points from phase 1 will be carried through to phase 2. Each team will then play six further matches in phase 2, within their groups, to determine the final positions in Divisions One and Two. At the end of the season, the top two teams of Division Two will be promoted to Division One, thus creating a ten team Division One for 2022 – 2023. There will be no relegation this season from Division One to Division Two, or from Division Two to Division Three. There will be promotion from Division Three to Division Two.
