

## REPORTING RESULTS AND MATCH REPORTS

In accordance with Rule 21.B, the home side is required to report the result of the match as instructed. Ian Scott will again be the link between the league and the website and will collate all results and goalscorers only.

We also ask the away team to report their goalscorers and goalkeepers 'clean sheets' to Ian Scott as above. Trophies are awarded for each division at the end of the season.

**COUNTY CUPS - All clubs**, irrespective of whether they are drawn home or away, must text or email their result as above by Sunday at 2.30pm **in addition to** reporting to the County FA as required by their rules.
